

Agricultural Mobile Robots

In the latest ASABE issue, new research concerning the usage of autonomous agricultural robots is being conducted in China. Researchers are using sequential point tracking algorithms to create a path for the robots to follow. Ideally, this would be used for collecting soil samples and sitespecific fertilization or feeding!
